(the "Company") announces preliminary terminal passenger traffic figures for January 2025, compared with January 2024. For January 2025, the total number of
terminal passengers at GAPac terminals increased by 6.3%, compared to January 2024. Guadalajara, Tijuana, Puerto Vallarta, and Los Cabos airports presented an increase in
passenger traffic of 9.9%, 5.2%, 1.9%, and 0.6%, respectively, compared to January 2024. On the other hand, Montego Bay presented a decrease in passenger traffic of 7.3%,
