For January 2025, the total number of terminal passengers at GAPâ€™s 12 Mexican airports increased by 6.3%, compared to January 2024. Guadalajara, Tijuana, Puerto Vallarta, and Los Cabos airports presented an increase in passenger traffic of 9.9%, 5.2%, 1.9%, and 0.6%, respectively, compared to January 2024. On the other hand, Montego Bay presented a decrease in passenger traffic of 7.3%, compared to January 2024. (GAP) operates 12 airports throughout Mexicoâ€™s Pacific region, including the major cities of Guadalajara and Tijuana, the four tourist destinations of Puerto Vallarta, Los Cabos, La Paz and Manzanillo, and six other mid-sized cities: Hermosillo, Guanajuato, Morelia, Aguascalientes, Mexicali, and Los Mochis. In February 2006, GAPâ€™s shares were listed on the New York Stock Exchange under the ticker symbol â€œPACâ€ and on the Mexican Stock Exchange under the ticker symbol â€œGAPâ€. In April 2015, GAP acquired 100% of Desarrollo de Concesion Aeropuertuarias, S.L., which owns a majority stake in MBJ Airports Limited, a company operating Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay, Jamaica. In October 2018, GAP entered into a concession agreement for the Norman Manley International Airport operation in Kingston, Jamaica, and took control of the operation in October 2019.
