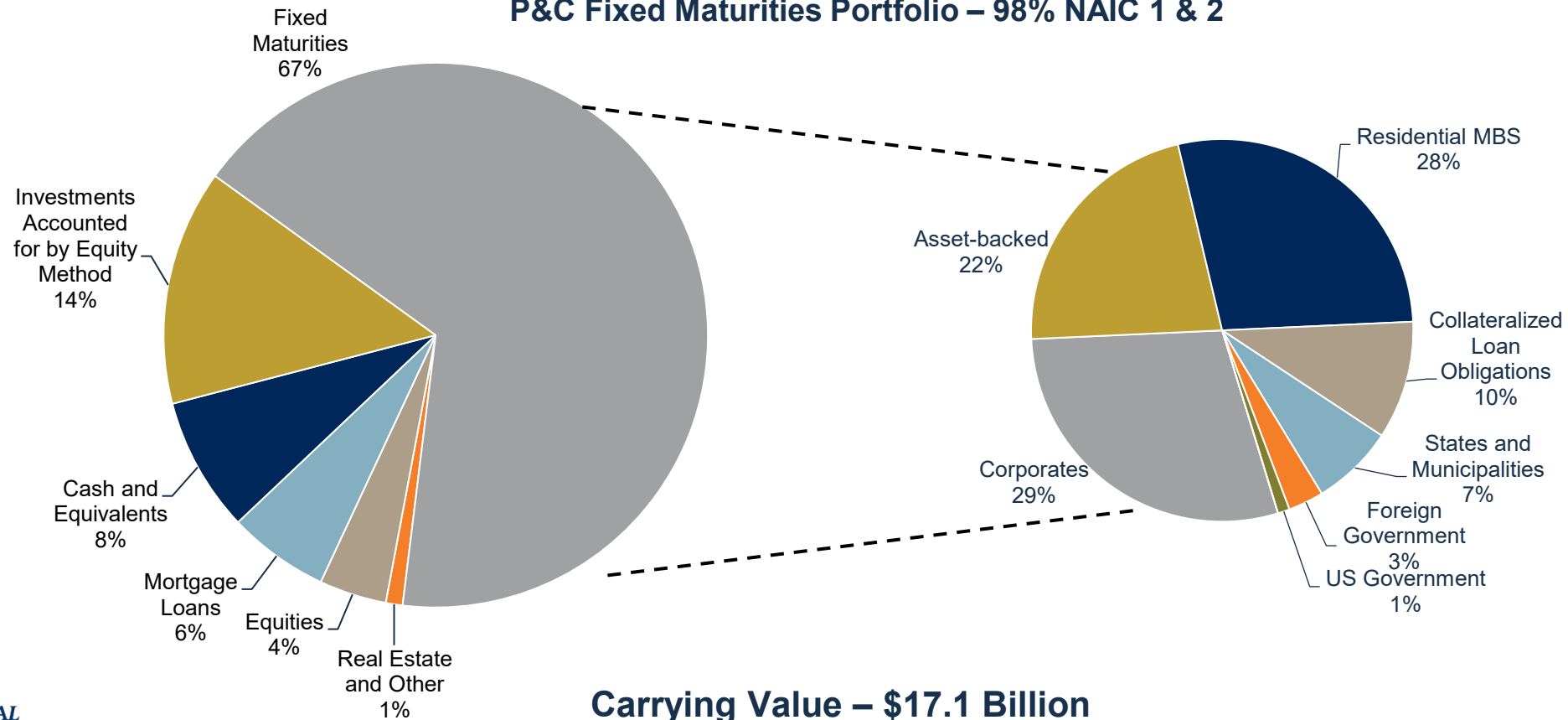
Investments

- Total carrying value of AFG's investment portfolio at March 31, 2026 = \$17.1 billion
- P&C net investment income excluding alternative investments up 8% YOY, down 1% overall.
 - First quarter 2026 annualized return of (0.4%) on AFG's \$2.8 billion of alternative investments
- First quarter after-tax net realized losses of \$15 million (\$0.18 per share loss)
 - Includes \$13 million in after-tax net realized losses (\$0.16 per share loss) to adjust equity securities that the company continued to own at March 31, 2026, to fair value through earnings
- In April 2026, AFG reached definitive agreements to sell the Charleston Harbor Resort & Marina
 - The transaction is expected to close in the second or third quarter of 2026
 - AFG currently expects to recognize a pretax core operating gain of approximately \$125 million on the sale.
